

This extremely well-written and interesting book is a terrific combination of page-turning readability and in-depth foreign policy expertise. I thoroughly enjoyed getting a behind-the-scenes (and behind the headlines) view of the inner workings of the Obama White House and Hillary Clintonâ [™]s State Department. More importantly, I came away feeling that I had learned a great deal from this well-researched and well-documented analysis of U.S. foreign policy. This book never strikes a false note. Landler describes policy, politics and personalities insightfully and often wittily. â œAlter Egosâ • sparkles with memorable quotes about people and places ranging from Benjamin Netanyahu ("a skilled, bare-knuckles bargainer with a cast-iron backside") to the U.S. Ambassador to Syria (â œgenteel but adventurous, Lawrence of Arabia with the voice of a librarianâ •) to San Pedro Sula, Honduras (â œa mangy industrial city known for clothing factories, rampant drug violence, and a string of strip malls pocked withâ • American fast-food franchises).In spite of writing about events that happened as long as eight years ago, Landler brings a freshness and immediacy to this material.
