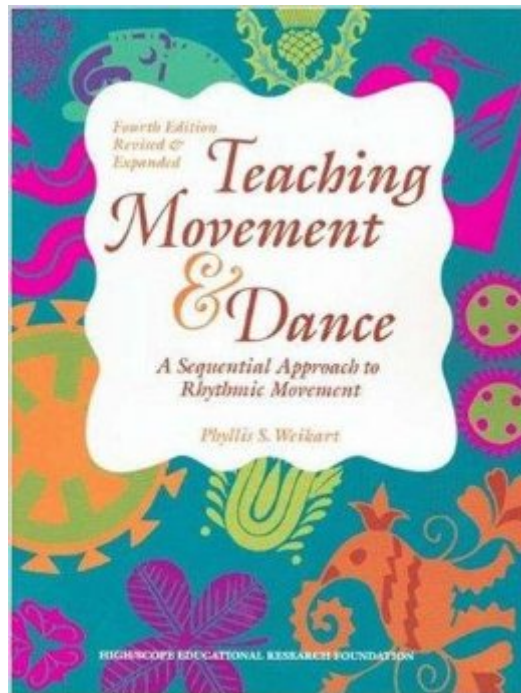


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# Teaching Movement & Dance: A Sequential Approach To Rhythmic Movement
